PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above made his declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42 and was evacuated on June 3/42. He lived at 139 Gary Rd., Steveston, with his son Michiharu MORI, who owned the house. Rihel MORI declared 6 gill nets and household effects and farm equipment left in care of Charles J. Jarvis, who was to reside in the house when the above and his family were evacuated. The file reveals that four gill nets and 2½ sets of lines were sold for the sum of \$160.00 and the proceeds credited jointly to the above and his son Michiharu, File 4969. Custodian cheques were issued to these two men on June 29/43 for \$100.00 and on Dec. 16/44 for \$60.00, thus closing out this joint account. 2 nets declared by the above were not found by the Custodian. Household effects are dealt with on the file of Michiharu MORI, No. 4969.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "MELINDA M", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$1,430.50, and this sum was paid to the above on April 9/42. All details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE:

The account of the above was credited with the sum of \$4.49 in July, 1945, being a refund from the B.C.E.R. of security deposit for light. A Custodian cheque for this sum is being remitted to him and the file closed.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Dear Sir:-

Further to our Administration Department's letter of June 28th, we are writing to advise you about fishing nets.

You yourself did not declare any nets or effects at all when you registered with us on April 20th although your father did declare six gill nets valued at \$600.00 left in the care of Mr. C. J. Jarvis. We notice from your letter of June 10th to the Security Commission that you now claim fishing nets valued at about \$800.00 stored in the upstairs room of your house.

You did, however, in February this year send us a completed net form but we are afraid we cannot identify all these nets and in any case, the values you have set on them would appear to be much exaggerated.

Those we could find have been sold for the undernoted prices.

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

The Custodian has today forwarded to Yasemon Hikida and Gihyoe Takahashi the sum of \$7,355.12 "In Trust". This represents the net proceeds from all the assets of the Steveston Nosan Kaisha.
