This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of B.C., and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42 and was evacuated on April 18/42, declared a few household effects as shown on J.P. form, stored at the MIYO SONJIN KAI apartment house, corner of 3rd Ave. and Moncton St., Steveston. At least eight Japanese families had their goods stored in this place. On Oct. 16/42 Custodian agent, Mr. C. C. Robinson, inventoried all the goods found at this address as per List #71 in the name of C. HAMAGUCHI, file 4493, and moved them to central storage. All goods that could be identified as belonging to the above were sold at auction for the net sum of \$10.57, and this sum was credited to his account with this office.
