GENERAL SUMMARY

Kanichi NAKAMOTO Decensed Reg. Mc. 10461

Kanichi MAKAMOTO died in Slocan on May 30, 1945. He is survived by his widow, Ura, file #330; four sons, Tsuneji, file #1134, Kenshiro, file #334, Kazuo, file #1132, and Mateuno, a minor; and three daughters, Alko, file #328, Sada, file #332, and Tomie, a minor.

The only assets declared by the deceased were a few chattels left at Prince Rupert. Some of these articles were shipped to Mrs. Makamoto, at her request, others were a old at mustice for the net amount of \$9.90. A further credit of \$2.62 was derived from a refund of deposit by the Northern B. C. Power Co. Ltd.

The deceased, in his Custodian declaration, stated that he was indebted to the Mochida Hotel in the sum of \$150.00 and to Ismanska, a grocer at Prince Rupert, in the sum of \$250.00.

Ismanska later filed a claim against Makamoto in the sum of \$428.47.

This amount was never acknowledged by Makamoto and, as he had no funds at that time, the oreditor was advised to seek settlement direct. A claim for funeral expenses was filed by the B. C.

Security Commission in the sum of \$80.00 but, in view of the small amount at credit, the Commission withdrew their claim on June 5, 1945.

As the preferred claim for funeral expenses was withdrawn by the B. C. Security Commission, the small credit balance of \$12.52 which was thereby released has been remitted to the widow.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.
