GENERAL SUMMARY

Kanichi NAKAMOTO died in Slocan on May 30, 1945. He is survived by his widow, Ura, file #330; four sons, Tsuneji, file #1134, Kenshiro, file #334, Kazuo, file #1132, and Matsuno, a minor; and three daughters, Aiko, file #328, Sada, file #332, and Tomie, a minor.

The only assets declared by the deceased were a few chattels left at Prince Rupert. Some of these articles were shipped to Mrs. Nakamoto, at her request, others were sold at auction for the net amount of \$9.90. A further credit of \$2.62 was derived from a refund of deposit by the Northern B. C. Power Co. Ltd.

The deceased, in his Custodian declaration, stated that he was indebted to the Mochida Hotel in the sum of \$150.00 and to Yamanaka, a grocer at Prince Rupert, in the sum of \$250.00. Yamanaka later filed a claim against Nakamoto in the sum of \$428.47. This amount was never acknowledged by Nakamoto and, as he had no funds at that time, the creditor was advised to seek settlement direct. A claim for funeral expenses was filed by the B. C. Security Commission in the sum of \$80.00 but, in view of the small amount at credit, the Commission withdrew their claim on June 5, 1945.

As the preferred claim for funeral expenses was withdrawn by the B. C. Security Commission, the small credit balance of \$12.52 which was thereby released has been remitted to the widow.

Dear Madam:

Re: Kanichi NAKAMOTO, Deceased.

Enclosed is Custodian cheque in your favour for the sum of \$12.52. This represents all funds to the credit of your late husband, Kanichi NAKAMOTO, in this office.

The only assets declared to the Custodian by either your husband or yourself were a few personal effects which you left at Prince Rupert. Some of these articles were shipped to you at your request, others were sold at auction for a net amount of \$9.90. A further credit of \$2.62 was derived from a refund of deposit by the Northern B. C. Pacer Co. Ltd.

Your husband, in his declaration to the Custodian, declared that he owed \$150.00 to Mr. Mochida, Mochida Hotel, Prince Rupert, and \$250.00 to Mr. Yamanaka, a grocer at Prince Rupert. Mr. Yamanaka later filed a claim against your husband for \$428.47. As there were no funds to your husband's credit in this office at that time, the creditors were advised to contact him direct in an endeavour to effect settlement. We have not been advised that these debts have been paid.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim against the estate of your husband for the sum of \$80.00 to cover his funeral expenses but, in view of the small credit balance in the account of your late husband, they have withdrawn their claim in order that these funds might be released for your use.
