If you are holding War Saving Certificates for your internee and if there are no claims on file against him, kindly have him paraded and ascertain whether or not it is his wish that his certificates be cancelled and that proceeds be sent to his sister.

With reference to the War Savings Certificates you are holding we suggest that you forward them direct, for redemption, to the Office of the Registrar, War Savings Committee, Ottawa.


