A wife is a preferred beneficiary and a policy cannot be surrendered without her consent.


Perhaps your mother or father are living and are resident in Canada, if this is the case, you could change the beneficiary to either of them and then he or she would sign as beneficiary. You may have a son or daughter who is over 21 years of age and residence in Canada and if so you could change the beneficiary to either him or her and so complete the necessary requirements to surrender the policy.

If none of the alternatives suggested above apply, then the only thing for you to do is to get in touch with the Office of the Custodian here and tell them of the situation requesting them to sign on behalf of your wife who is resident in Japan.

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
