The above made his declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42 , was intermed on June 24/42 and released July 17/43.

He declared chattels as listed on the Chattel Schedule on file left at House \$24 - 5th Eve., Steveston, owned by the Canadian Fighing Co. Ltd.

On July 24/42, Mrs. Matsuro KAWANO, File 11098, wife of the above, sent in a Custodian Release for A mattresses, 2 or 3 boxes of kitchenware. These apparently could not be found at this time as they were never shipped.

On Nov. 13/43 Custodian agent, Mr. C. G. Mobinson reported that he had had an interview with Mr. Townsend, Manager of the Canadian Fishing Co. Ltd., and that Mr. Townsend had advised him that House #24 had been thousand out by them, that there was nothing of value in the noise and that what had been found by them was burned as rubbish.

However, on July 10/43, our agent, Mr. C.C. Hobinson, inventoried chattels in the name of the above as per list #430 on file, found in a house out by V. SAKADE, File 93A3, on Chathan St., Steveston. This house was used as a storage place by many other Japanese. The chattels on List #430 were moved to central storage and have been disposed of as shown on the Schedule. The goods sold at our Steveston auctions in the name of the above amounted to \$6.00%, and this sum was credited to the account of the above. Certain goods appearing on List #430, as per our memo to Miss C. Girard, were not declared by the above, and the proceeds from their sale has been transferred to Chattel Suspense Account.
