The above, who made his declaration to the Fustodian on April 4/42 and was evacuated on April 23/42, declared fishing equipment as listed on the Chattal Schedule. He stated that this equipment was stored at the Northern Pacific Cannary, Skeens Siver,

On May 11/42 we received a letter from the Anglo-British Columbia Packing to, giving us a list of names of Japanese and asking if these Japanese owed any money as they wished to purchase nets owned by these Japanese for their Northern Pacific Cannery. The name of the Loove was included on this list. This tompany was advised by our office on May 13/42 that it would be quite in order to buy nets belonging to the above at a reasonable valuation. They were asked to advise us when these purchases were made and to send us a description of the nets and the prices paid in each case. No reply was received to this letter.

On June 7/43 we wrote to Seiichi TSUMURA and asked him to configuration that his note declared to the Custodian had been purchased by arrangement with his by the A.H.C.Pheking Co., and advised his that unless we heard from his to the contrary we would assume that he had no further property in the restricted area of British Volumbia. No reply was received to this letter.

The household goods were declared by the wife of Selichi TSUMURA, and are dealt with on her file, No. 2792.
