RE: Seiichi TSUMURA, Reg.No. 03827

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42 and was evacuated on April 23/42, declared fishing equipment as listed on the Chattel Schedule. He stated that this equipment was stored at the Northern Pacific Cannery, Skeena River, B.C.

On May 11/42 we received a letter from the Anglo-British Columbia Packing Co. giving us a list of names of Japanese and asking if these Japanese owed any money as they wished to purchase nets owned by these Japanese for their Northern Pacific Cannery. The name of the above was included on this list. This company was advised by our office on May 13/42 that it would be quite in order to buy nets belonging to the above at a reasonable valuation. They were asked to advise us when these purchases were made and to send us a description of the nets and the prices paid in each case. No reply was received to this letter.

On June 7/43 we wrote to Seiichi TSUMURA and asked him to confirm that his nets declared to the Custodian had been purchased by arrangement with him by the A.B.C. Packing Co., and advised him that unless we heard from him to the contrary we would assume that he had no further property in the restricted area of British Columbia. No reply was received to this letter.

The household goods were declared by the wife of Seiichi TSUMURA, and are dealt with on her file, No. 2792.
