GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Jujiro NAKATSU, Reg. No. 10219  
Deceased

This man was a logger at Stillwater, B. C. He signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 19, 1942, at Hastings Park. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942. The Japanese evacuated from Stillwater were not given much time to prepare for leaving, according to reports appearing in File A/76. As a result tools were left in the woods where the men had been working and at the places where they had been living. Their goods were left without any preparation for the owners being away, as the owners had no time to make preparations. The areas in which the men had been working were difficult to reach, and due to this inaccessibility none of the tools or other goods were removed by the Custodian, nor was an inventory made of the goods left in the bush or at shacks occupied by some of the Japanese.

NAKATSU declared no real property and none is revealed in his file.

NAKATSU reported ownership of tools, which he valued at \$158.60. These tools, he stated, had been left in a small shack in the bush about 1 1/2 miles from the logging camp at 3rd Lake, Stillwater, B.C. None of these tools have been inventoried or removed by the Custodian. A list of the tools is attached to the declaration of Jujiro NAKATSU on this file.

NAKATSU declared approximately \$140.00 due him from M. Ebisuzaki Co., against which there would be a charge of about \$22.00 for board. With the aid of Bunzo TAIRA, File 1410, who had operated one of the logging camps at Stillwater, P. S. Ross & Sons, prepared a statement showing the amounts due the various Japanese who had worked with TAIRA. This statement shows that NAKATSU received credit for 80 cords of shingle bolts out, at \$2.30 a cord, a total of \$184.00. From this was deducted the sum of \$80.28 to cover board due M. Ebisuzaki Co., leaving a net credit of \$103.72, which is being transferred to the account of NAKATSU today.

NAKATSU declared one \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This was not brought under the control of this office.

No other assets or liabilities are revealed by this file. No liabilities are shown in the file of Mrs. Jujiro NAKATSU, File 617.
