The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 4/42 and was evacuated on April 29/42, lived with her brother, I.MURAKAMI, File 661, at the Colonial Cannery, and declared the following goods:

2 Beds 1 Sofa 1 Bureau 1 Trunk

Kitchen utensils

Chattels found at House #7, Colonial Cannery, were inventoried by Custodian agent, C.C.Robinson, on July 7/42, List #73, in the name of "I. MURAKANI" and moved to warehouse #2, and on August 13/42. a further group of chattels as per List #46, was inventoried and moved to storage in the Japanese Church. 1 Winnipeg couch, tagged with the name of the above, was the only article that could be identified as belonging to Mrs. OKINO, and this was sold at auction for the net sum of \$3.14 and this amount credited to her account with the Custodian.

Although a memo on file dated May 11/45 states that the chattels of the above are included with those of her brother, it was impossible to identify the above chattels on his list of goods. It is possible that Mrs. OKINO disposed of, or took with her on evacuation, the other goods she declared.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

BANK ACCOUNT: The above declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada at Steveston in the sum of \$400.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.
