PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Takeshi NISHIDA #09389

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 18, 1942. The following day he was evacuated. In September, 1942, this man was interned, but was released on parole in November, 1942.

In his declaration of March 18, 1942, he reported a quantity of musical instruments and equipment left at the home of his parents in Woodfibre. On February 20, 1943, he informed this office that these had been taken to Kaslo by his father.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond, but as this is not mentioned in the declaration made by him following his inter ment it would appear that he had disposed of this.

He declared \$130.00 in War Savings Certificates, but following his internment reported \$160.00 in these Certificates. His 16 War Savings Certificates were in safeskeeping by the Custodian during the internment of this man but were returned to him on March 8, 1943.

His bank account #344, Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings, Vancouver, came under the control of this office following his internment, and on September 17, 1942, the Royal Bank sent to the Custadian cheque for \$257.84 representing the balance to the credit of this man at that date. This money was placed to the credit of his account with this office.

The Manufacturers Life Insurance Policy, which he declared, was not at any time in the possession of this office, but we have paid, at the request of Takeshi NISHIDA, premiums on this policy as follows: March 11, 1943 - \$37.86; March 14, 1944 - \$28.62; March 12, 1945 - \$34.37, and he has requested that we pay the premium for 1946, in the amount of \$34.37, and this is being attended to.

From his funds, at his request, we paid the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Association the sum of \$72.00 to cover payment due on his father's Endowment Installment Shares, on May 21, 1943.

At the time of his internment he reported back-wages due from the Department of Mines and Resources of \$18.00. Cheque for \$15.83 was received in payment of back-wages on September 12, 1942, and an additional cheque for \$5.63 from this source on September 26, 1942. These funds were credited to his account.

Refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941, in the amount of \$6.79, was credited to his account.

Cheque for \$12.76 in payment of over-payment of 1941 Income Tax was sent to him on August 17, 1943, by this office, without having been placed in his account.

On February 27, 1943, we remitted to NISHIDA \$28.25 from his funds. His credit balance at this time is \$84.99.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file, March 7, 1946.

Following your arrival in Kaslo the Custodian's file in connection with your affairs has been transferred to this section.

Attached you will find a statement covering your account with us from which you will observe that you have a credit balance with us at this time of \$236.09. Our records also indicate that we are holding in trust for you sixteen \$10.00 Mar Savings Certificates regarding which we would appreciate hearing from you as to that disposition you desire be made of them.

Our records further show that you are the owner of Manufacturers Life Insurance Company twenty-five year endowment policy, No. 687,076, for \$1,000.00. We would also appreciate hearing from you in connection with this policy.

In conclusion, we note that when you registered your assets with the Custodian on March 18th, 1942 you declared that you had left with your parents five Japanese flutes, a violin, some music and three music stands, and in order that our records may be complete we would appreciate your advising us as to disposition made by you of this equipment which presumably may have been taken by your father on your behalf.

This is to inform you that, as requested in your letter received on March 7th, we are requisitioning from your funds chaque for 134-37 to be sent to the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company in payment of premium due. Oustodien chaque for the remainder of the funds standing to your credit, \$50.62, is analoged Premith.

Mour file with this office has been reviewed and it reveals that the musical instruments and oculpment which you reported in your declaration to the Custodian were taken to Easle by your parents.

The \$50.00 Victory Bund which you declared appears to have been disposed of by you grior to September, 1942, as this was not among the assets reported by you at that date. The 16 \$10.00 Mar Savings Certificates which were held in enfo-keeping by the Oustedian were returned to you on March 8, 1943.

The sum of \$257.64, received from the Royal Bank of Canada, on September 17, 1942, and representing the credit balance in your bank account at that date, was placed to your credit with this office.

Presiums on your Manufacturers Life Insurance Company policy have been paid from your funds for the years 1943, 1944, 1945; the total sum thus paid amounted to \$100.85. Se also paid from your funds, at your request, the sum of \$72.00 to the Yorkshire Savings & Loss Association, in connection with your father's Endowment Installment Shares.

The refund of one per cent mage deductions for the year 1941 mas received by this office and credited to your account. This assumted to \$6.79. The refund of over-payment of Income Fax for 1941, assumting to \$12.76, was sent on to you on August 17, 1943, by this office.

In September, 1942, we received from the Receiver General of Canada, a total of \$21.46, in payment of back-mages due you from the Department of Mines and Resources. This money was credited to your account.

On Pebruary 27, 1943, we remitted to you chaque for \$28.25. The various disbursements made from your account, including the two chaques being requisitioned today, total \$286.09, which is the total amount paid in to your account with
