LIABILITY SUMMARY

Re: Gorokichi KARIYA, Reg. No. 10434.

A memorandum from Mr. Spain, dated December 24, 1942 states that Mrs. KARIYA owes the Canada Mio Co. about \$3,000.00. As will be seen in W. G. Bell's memorandum of January 5, 1943, H. D. Campbell who investigated this woman's affairs stated that the husband had no interest whatsoever in the business.

While this statement was not substantiated in any way, the administration of the file was carried out accordingly and the claims handled on the wife's file exclusively.

This file reveals no other liabilities.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: Gorokichi KARIYA - Reg. No. 10434.

KARIYA signed a declaration from the Internment Camp. This is undated. He had previously declared his property to the Custodian on November 7, 1942, but did not sign as he stated that he had already registered. He was probably referring to his wife's declaration. He was interned on November 18, 1942 (?). He was released sometime in 1946. His P.W.A. Number while interned was 711.

CHATELS: He declared that he rented 243 Powell St. from "Agent Mizuhara for \$35.00. This property belonged to the Canada Mio Co., File 9571 of which Joe MIZUHARA was the agent.

KARIYA declared in general terms, 2 rooms of furniture. However, in his undated declaration signed at the Internment Camp, he declared "all necessary articles for Jap Restaurant and personal belongings worth \$4,000.00 at 203 Powell St. This would appear to be the wrong address. The chattels were all handled on the wife's file, 6657.

SPECIFIED Radio:

ARTICLES: He declared a radio left with the R. C. M. P. This was likewise handled on the wife's file. The Radio was surrendered by her.

Vessel: The file reveals that the Vessel Porcher G. owned by Gorokichi KARIYA was sold to the Canadian Fishing Co. on March 2, 1942. The balance of the purchase price, after payment of mortgage was \$2,905.75. It was paid to the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee who deducted supervision charges of \$44.00. The resulting balance, \$2,861.75 was paid to the owner on March 23, 1942. For further details see the Vessel Summary.

LIFE

INSURANCE: He declared \$2,000.00 policy with the Sun Life Insurance Co., in his wife's possession. Form D. was filed by the insurance company. This form indicated that the policy would carry itself until October 1952. Premium notice was received and KARIYA asked what he desired to do. He failed to reply. The last notice received since KARIYA's release was forwarded to him. There is no record that this policy ever came to this office for safekeeping.

MONEYSOWING:

The sum of \$7.10 was received from the Prince Rupert Fishermen's Co-operative Association, through the B. C. Security Commission, in payment of 58 lbs. of viscera, less deductions. This was credited to this account.

At the time of KARIYA's release from the Internment Camp, his camp cash balance \$1.20 was forwarded to this office. This, together with the above were remitted to KARIYA on May 5, 1947.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
