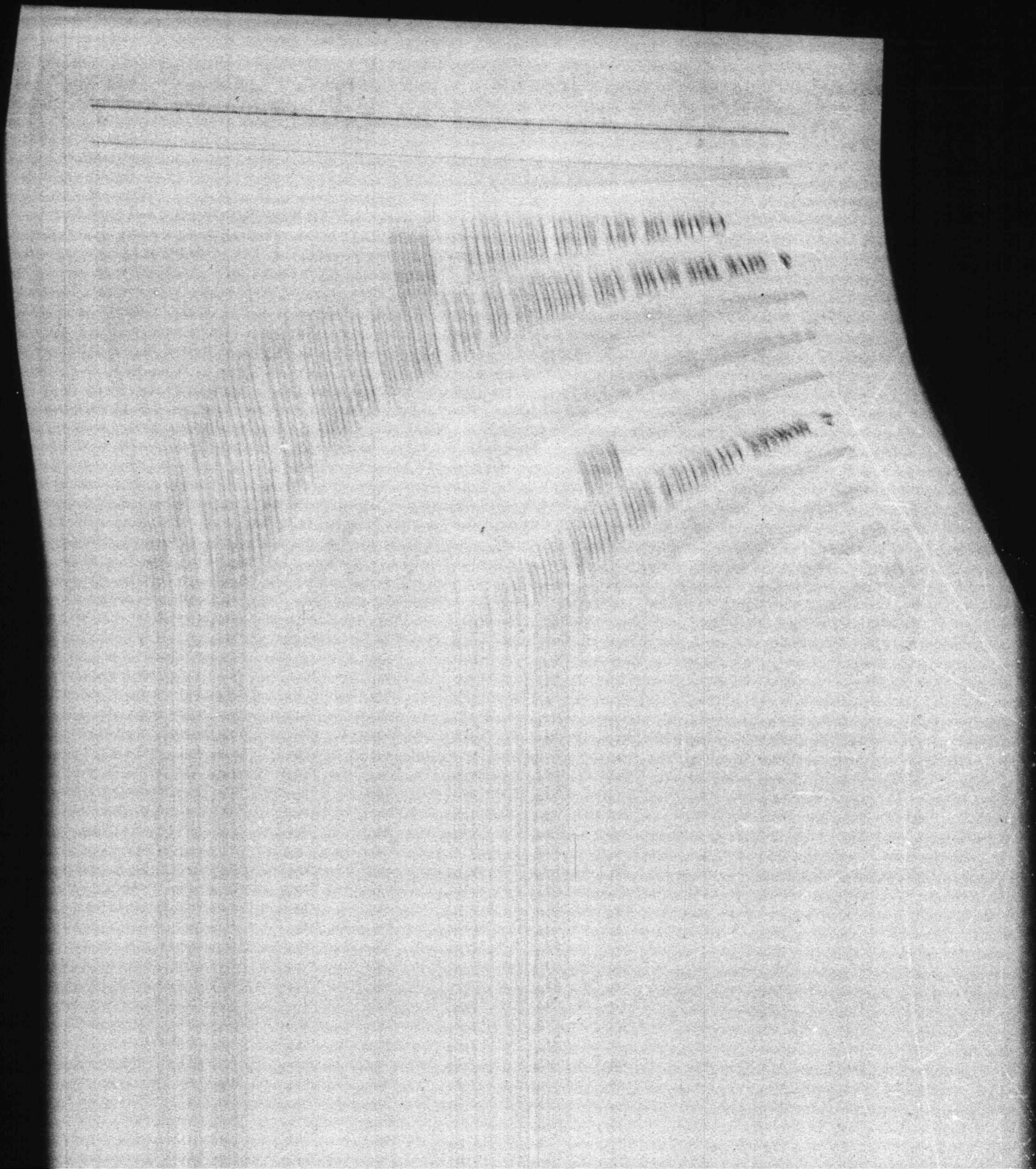

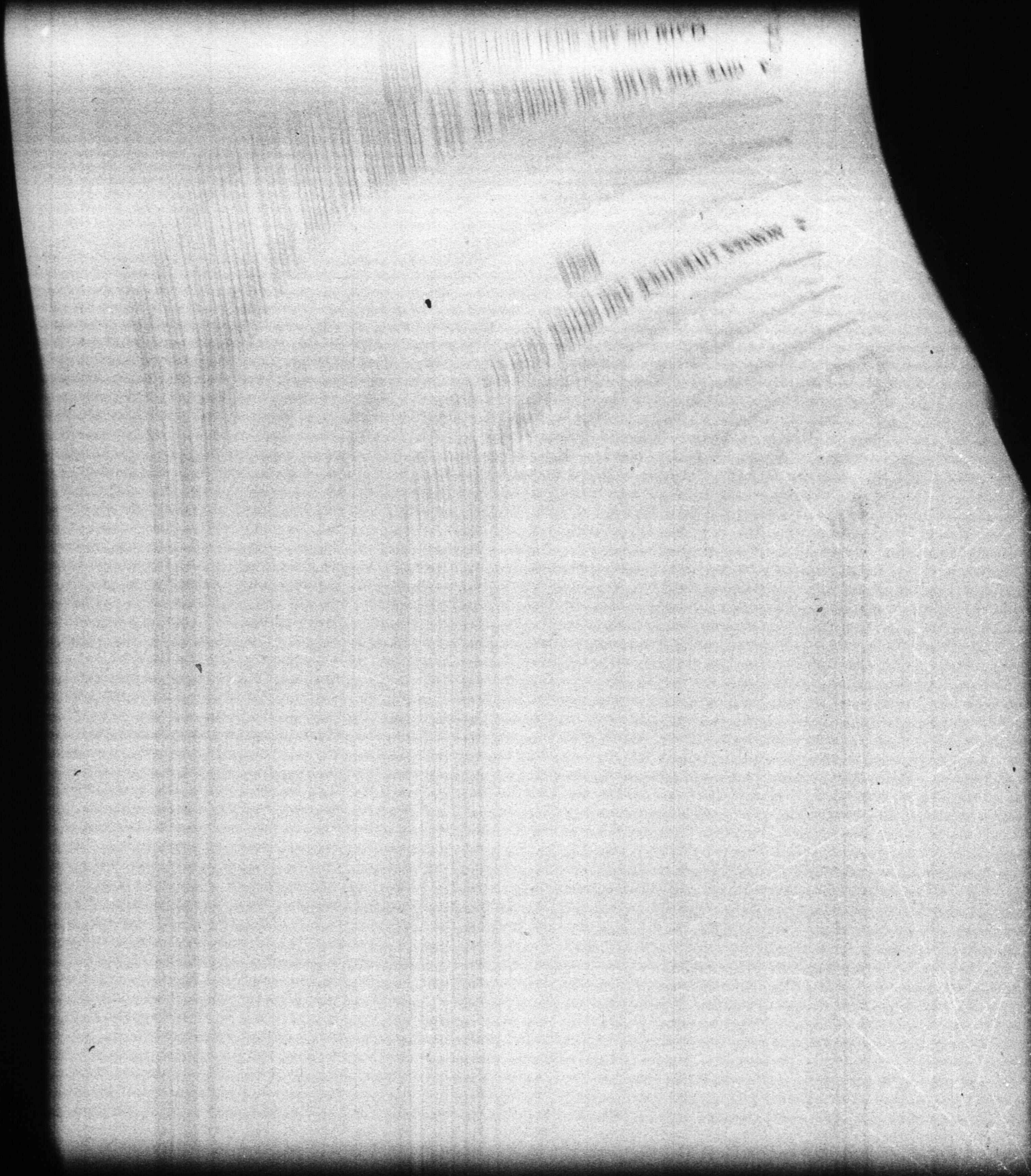

In replying your letter dated on Dec. 2nd 1942, I, Ryuta Morisawa, (Reg. No. 01640) I do feel so sorry that I delayed to let you know. However since I had to move from camp to camp for these months, that is; from Grant Brook to Red Pass, and to Black Spur Camp and here I am at last, at Lempriere Camp; and these removing caused me missing the time

to write you soon.

At any rate, I'm still looking for & wanting to know the whereabouts of my trunk in which I've been asked under take care of Mr. Suzuki.

I tried getting in touch with him but he had already moved somewhere out of Vancouver City.

I'm not sure yet, but I heard that he moved to Greenwood about. I ~~don't~~ ^{don't} hear from him and don't receive the trunk either.

I will appreciate it very very much if you could get in touch with Mr. Suzuki & I like you'll protect it under your care.

I'm told also that, ^{unless} whoever did not register at

Custodian by 19th inst
they will dismiss your
protection. If that's so,
I guess writing now will
scarcely be effective.

Though I'm afraid-
ing that it seems a kind
of too late, I do hope
kindly you'll inquire
my trunk & protect it.

Thanks ever so much
beforehand & will appreci-
ate it very much.
