PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: Shichiro NAKAYAMA, Reg. No. 07738

This man is reported by the RCMP to have been a fisherman and a boat owner. He was taken into custody by the police on November 1, 1942, at his residence 828 East Cordova Street, Vancouver, charged with being in the protected area after October 31, 1942. He was sent to Oakalla Prison, from there to the Immigration Building and on November 23, 1942, he was sent to internment camp.

On this file are two JP forms, both unsigned and bearing notations that NAKAYAMA had refused to sign. One is dated October 15, 1942, and mentions a bank account. The other, dated November 10, 1942, refers to furniture left at 828 East Cordova, premises stated to belong to Odlum Co. Real Estate. No details of the furniture are given.

In regard to the bank account, on November 16, 1942, the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings, informed this office that the sum of \$181.80 had been withdrawn from the account of Shichiro NAKAYAMA, a barber, of 882 East Hastings Street. That no funds remained on deposit. The City Directory of 1941 gives the occupant of 882 East Hastings as Mrs. R. NAKAYAMA, barber, and it is noted that the wife of Shichiro NAKAYAMA gives her address as 882 East Hastings Street. Her file is 12011.

On November 9, 1942, this office asked Harold D. Campbell to investigate 828 East Cordova, as the RCMP had stated there were perishable goods in the premises. On November 17, 1942, Mr. Campbell reported that the building was a residence. In the meantime Mr. Odlum, of the Mercantile Mortgage Co, landlord, had telephoned this office advising that the building was locked up and asking that the chattels be removed. Mr. T. Ellis of this office, upon investigating, reported on November 18, 1942, that he had found the building unlocked and a man asleep in one of the beds and thinking that an error had been made in the address, Mr. Ellis did not talk with the man but stated he was getting in touch with the landlord. On November 19, 1942, arrangements were made to remove to 604 East Cordova the chattels, and on November 23, 1942, the chattels listed in the chattel schedule were removed. There is nothing further on file in regard to the man found in the house by Mr. Ellis. It is noted however that between the time of the first inventory of goods in the house, November 21, 1942, and the date of the removal to storage of the goods, the building was broken into and a trunk was taken.

It will be seen by the Chattel Schedule that a number of items listed on the inventory as having been removed to storage are not accounted for by sale. There is no record of any shipment of the chattels of this man. The net proceeds of the sale of goods sold at auction were \$93.19. These were placed in his account in this office.

The sum of \$5.43 was credited to the account of Shichiro NAKAYAMA as refund of B. C. Electric Railway Co. security deposit for light at 828 East Cordova Street.

Although the RCMP sheet states that NAKAYAMA was a fisherman and a boat owner, and the unsigned JP of NAKAYAMA states that he was a fisherman employed by Nelson Bros., Smith Inlet, B. C., NAKAYAMA did not report ownership of a fishing vessel, and there is no record of a vessel owned by him having been taken into custody or having been reported to the Custodian.

The sum of \$11.00 was sent to H.K.Naruse on September 8, 1945, to pay for optical treatment for Shichiro NAKAYAMA, who at that time was at New Denver Sanatorium.

On December 16, 1946, an inquiry was received from the Department of Labour in regard to two trunks which NAKAYAMA was said to have left at 828 East Cordova. We have a record of one trunk, as stated previously, but no record of the other trunk.

The funds in the account of this man on December 30, 1946, amounted to \$87.62. A cheque for this amount was sent to him, but has been returned as he refused to accept it.
