

Dear Sir:

Answering your letter of June 1st, your file No. P/W A-751 and in connection with the membership of Risuke Ikeda in this Association, on referring to our records I find that this member in August, 1941, applied \$22.50 in prepayment of calls and this amount took care of his membership until April 15 of this year on which date it was found necessary to make an additional call amounting to \$2.50. Notice of this call was mailed to Mr. Ikeda to his last given address, c/o Inosuke Nishikawa, c/o D. Riehl, R. C. 1, Nobleford, Alberta. In addition to the notice requiring payment, a second notice was mailed to this member drawing his attention to his oversight and all of which appear to have been disregarded.

The above payment, as applied, were each in the sum of \$2.50 and covered calls No. 27, due October 15, 1941, No. 28, due January, 1942, No. 29, due April 15, 1942, No. 30, due July 15, 1942, No. 31, due October 15, 1942, No. 32, due January 15, 1943 and No. 33, due April 15, 1943; and Annual Dues of \$5.00 due on August 18 of last year making a total of \$22.50. As stated above, on April 15 of this year in addition to our Mortuary-Trust-Fund call No. 33, owing to claims experience it was necessary to make an additional call—No. 33A--also due on April 15 last. This is the call for which we have received no payment. On July 15 next a further call is being made on our members in the sum of \$3.50. This is made up of the normal call of \$2.50 for Mortuary-Trust Fund purposes and plus an additional \$1.00 for Reserve Fund. On August 18 next, the sum of \$5.00 will be required for Annual Dues. Amount past due--\$2.50. \$11.00 will keep this membership in good standing—until October 15, next.
