PERSONAL PROPERTY MEMORANDUM

Re: P/W A-750, ATSUMI, Toraichi

The above named was the owner of fishing vessel "T.A." which was sold to H. Bell-Irving Company Ltd. for \$650.00 and the proceeds were paid directly to him by the J.F.V.D.C. on March 31, 1942.

The Internee declared two fishing nets, 1 Salmon 5 7/8, 4 ply, 50 meshes, 200 fathom; 1 gray fish 5 7/8, 4 ply, 25 meshes, 400 fathom; - These nets were not included in the Custodian's net inventory - no trace has been found.

There are no accounts receivable.

The Internee has no funds at credit with the Custodian - there is a small balance of approximately \$5.00 at the Internment Camp.


