This can eighed a declaration to the Gustodian on March 19, 1942. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942.

Prior to his evacuation, MORITA was emplyed as a logger by Mobert MoMair Shingle Company, Stillenter, B. C.

CHATTER

MORITA reported logging equipment loft at Stillwater. The evecuation from Stillenter was very sudden and the Japanese had no time to arrange for the storage or shipment of their goods. Mr. Green's memo of April 30, 1943, states that it was impossible to identify emerging of the tools left in the camps and that there were tools in the bush which could only be found by the Japanese themselves. For this reason, far or no cultimater chattels have been accounted for. Nothing further can be done in regard to monthly tools unless he should claim for the loss of them.

MADULTATEST

MORITA reported that he had overdrawn \$50.00 at the Stillwater Camp. On July 18, 1922, we wrote to MORITA advising him that we presumed that he had settled this debt prior to his evacuation, but if not, to send us the funds to pay this claim. No reply was received. As no claim was filed by M. EBISUZAKI Company against MORITA, and his name does not appear on their records, no further action has been taken by this office.

MORITA reported a farm house in Okayama, Japan. No interest was taken in this house by
