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GENERAL SUMMARY

October 8, 1947.

Re: Susataro MORIYA, Reg. No. 10225

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 19, 1942. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942.

Prior to his evacuation, MORIYA was employed as a logger by Robert McWair Shingle Company, Stillwater, B. C.

CHATELS

MORIYA reported logging equipment left at Stillwater. The evacuation from Stillwater was very sudden and the Japanese had no time to arrange for the storage or shipment of their goods. Mr. Green's memo of April 30, 1943, states that it was impossible to identify ownership of the tools left in the camps and that there were tools in the bush which could only be found by the Japanese themselves. For this reason, few or no Stillwater chattels have been accounted for. Nothing further can be done in regard to MORIYA's tools unless he should claim for the loss of them.

LIABILITIES:

MORIYA reported that he had overdrawn \$50.00 at the Stillwater Camp. On July 18, 1944, we wrote to MORIYA advising him that we presumed that he had settled this debt prior to his evacuation, but if not, to send us the funds to pay this claim. No reply was received. As no claim was filed by M. EBISUZAKI Company against MORIYA, and his name does not appear on their records, no further action has been taken by this office.

MORIYA reported a farm house in Okayama, Japan. No interest was taken in this house by the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
