GENERAL SUMMARY

August 20, 1946.

Re: Sukuo SANESHIMA, Reg. No. Q7487

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 21, 1942.  
He was evacuated on September 28, 1942.

In his declaration he reported shoe repairing machines stored with Storey & Campbell, Vancouver. Storey & Campbell confirmed holding these machines, stating they would look after them until such time as SANESHIMA required them. We assume they are still being held by that firm.

He reported seven \$5.00 War Savings Certificates being held by Storey & Campbell. These were forwarded to SANESHIMA through this office on March 17, 1945.

He reported a \$2,500.00 policy with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. This did not come under the control of this office.

H. G. Hinton reported that this man has a credit balance of \$32.59 with Storey & Campbell. Nothing has been done by this office about this balance.
