GENERAL SUMMARY

August 20, 1946.

Re: Masataro SAKURADA, Reg. No. 10713

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 28, 1942. He was evacuated on May 18, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a fishing boat, a seine net, a drum and roller at B.C. Packers, Wadhams Cannery, Rivers Inlet, B.C. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that the vessel was sold and the net proceeds of \$146.00 were paid to SAKURADA on September 22, 1942. The net, drum and roller were destroyed by fire at the Cannery and the account of this man was credited with the sum of \$100.00 received from B. C. Packers as payment for this loss. This was remitted to SAKURADA on March 1, 1943, April 5, 1943 and May 25, 1943.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession and a bank account with a balance of \$2,386.67 in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. These items did not come under the control of this office.

The R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Phonola radio surrendered by this man. This was released to the B. C. Security Commission on August 19, 1944 for shipment to SAKURADA, receipt being on file.
