**ASSETS:**

A cheque issued by Business Investments Ltd. for \$500.00 in March 1941 in favour of Kazutoshi HATAKEYAMA on the Dominion Bank, Robson and Hornby Branch, Vancouver, B.C. was certified by the Bank. According to registration Apr. 2/42 by HATAKEYAMA page 3. "This cheque was lost soon after receipt in March 1941. The Dominion Bank was notified of the loss. A lawyer named Murphy was entrusted with the case". Briefly stated the file is full of letters written in an endeavour to arrive at some means of negotiating the cheque. The Bank would not release the funds except on a satisfactory Bond of Indemnity in double the amount being given them. The final letter Jan 30/46 indicates that "we do not consider that there is anything further that we can do". HATAKEYAMA has not in the meantime received the money so far as our records show.

No other Assets are revealed on the file.

**LIABILITIES:**

A Claim was filed by Woodworth & Woodworth Ltd. on behalf of Dr. G.E. Brown for \$34.55 for professional services rendered the late R. GOTO. This claim was later withdrawn as same was not an indebtedness of KAZUTOSHI HATAKEYAMA. Our letter 30-3-43 to HATAKEYAMA closed the matter so far as HATAKEYAMA and this office was concerned.

No Liabilities against HATAKEYAMA are revealed on the file.




