This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 23, 1942. He was evacuated on September 26, 1942.

In his declaration he reported furnishings for a 3-room house, left at O'Brien Bay, B.C. These were shipped to SAKAMOTO as requested by him on June 5, 1942.

He reported \$150.00 in Victory Bonds and a bank account with a balance of \$719.27 in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver. These did not come under the control of this office.

He reported an account with the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. with a balance of \$150.00. As this man's name does not appear on the list of depositors of that company as at December 31, 1942 we assume he withdrew his account prior to that date.

He reported a \$2,000.00 policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co. On November 21, 1945 a cheque for \$375.62 was forwarded to SAKAMOTO through this office as the cash surrender value of his policy.
