The writer discussed this with the Manag er of Claxton before he left Vancouver and he was instructed to get in touch with the Rupert Agent for the Custodian to burn or destroy all remaining goods of Japanese that were of no value and to arrange with the Agent re any goods still remaining that had any value.

We feel that you should have your Agent get in touch with our local manager in case there are any goods still the property of the Japanese.
