MEMORANDUM: File 1240

January 8, 1945.

Re. Kingo SAKAMOTO, #11166

This man did not declare ownership of a fishing vessel.

There is no record of a vessel belonging to this man being impounded or sold.

On the list, supplied by B. C. Packers Ltd., of vessels which had fished at Claxton Cannery, there appears the following:

"C.C.43" owned by K. Sakamoto, Lic.#1186, Naval No. PR.093-R - No balance owing B.C. Packers. "

As Kingo Sakamoto declared fishing gear left at Claxton, it is possible that he is the K. Sakamoto who owned the "C.C.43". As he did not declare ownership, it would appear that he had disposed of the boat before he registered with the Custodian.
