This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. She was evacuated on May 28, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a sewing machine and kitchen stove left in her brother's house at Ucluelet. These articles were included in a room-by-room inventory made by her brother of the contents of his house, and as he has stated they are now living together, these articles are handled on the file of her brother, File No. 3383, *and appear to have been shipped to him.*

She reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and \$20.00 in War Savings Certificates in her own possession, and a bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver, with a balance of \$500.00. These items did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
