PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

August 27, 1946.

Re: YASUO KANAYA, Reg. No. 10413

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. He was evacuated on July 11, 1942 according to a letter from him.

In his declaration he reported 3 trunks left at Lindsay Cartage & Storage, Prince Rupert. On June 25, 1942, 2 of these trunks were shipped to KANAYA at Hastings Park and the third one was shipped to KANAYA at Slocan in September, 1942. See postscript.

He reported 3 wooden boxes, a blanket bag, a mattress and 2 clothes baskets left c/o Mr. Richard Long, 1222 Beach Place, Prince Rupert. These articles and a stove were shipped to him on May 19, 1942.

He reported \$12.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

The Canadian National Railways advised us on May 26, 1942 that they had a credit of \$215.00 for this man in the employees Pension Fund. We authorized them to pay this amount direct to KANAYA.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$9.93 received as refund of National Defense Tax for 1942. \$6.00 of this amount was paid to Standard Oil to satisfy a claim and \$3.93 was remitted to KANAYA on November 1, 1943.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Kanaya during his employment which was terminated on March 15th, 1942, had contributed approximately \$215.- to the employees Pension Fund and has now requested that this amount be refunded to him. His request is in accord with the regulations governing the operation of the Fund but before taking any action in the matter we would be glad to be advised if we have your authority to make payment of the amount involved directly to Kanaya.

Dear Sir:-

In regard to our chattels, we didn't answer your last letter as we ordered for the only trunk we left in the storage at Prince Rupert, before we left Hastings Park on July 11th.

We had a few articles in the storage and ordered for everything but one trunk which belong to a son (J. Kanaya) who is in Ontario sugar beets. We didn't order for this trunk as we thought it would be no use and would be in our way. But by some mistake this trunk came & my wife's trunk was left behind. As she has practically all her clothing in this trunk, we got the custodian at Hastings Park to send for it & then to get it sent here. It's been over a month now and we haven't had any word about it. We have been waiting for this trunk so I didn't write you. Whether it is still in the storage in Prince Rupert, I don't know. Would you please look into the matter and oblige.

Comments on above :

Investigation at City Hall discloses that a property at 1127 Water Street was sold by Kanaya to one Harry Long in fee simple on 21st March 1942. No agreement or mortgage indicated in City records; search at Land Registry Office impossible today. Transfer registered at L.R.O. at 10.30 a.m. on above date. Actual evacuation of Japanese in this area took place at noon on the same day.

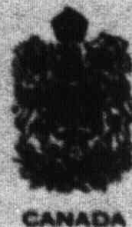
