This men signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 19, 1942. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942, and repatriated to Japan on December 24, 1946.

Prior to his evacuation, SAITO, was employed as a logger by the McMair Shingle Company, (Tairs Camp) Stillwater, B. C.

CHATTELS

SAITO reported logging equipment left at Stillwater camp. As the evacuation from Stillwater was very sudden, the Japanese had no time to arrange for the shipment or storage of their goods. Mr. Gran's memo of April 30, 1943, states that it was impossible to identify comerchip of the tools left in the camp, and for the most part, equipment left at Stillwater could not be accounted for. Nothing further can be done in regard to SAITO's tools, and as he has returned to Japan, it is not likely that there will be enquiries as to the whereabouts of his equipment.

HOLLES OFFICE

The following note, signed by Miss Matheson, and dated September 15, 1947, appears on the Claims Sheet filed under date of December 15, 1943.

"A claim in the amount of \$50.59 was filed against M. EBISUZAKI Co. by Yoshikasu SUZUKI, File 2510, for wages owing to Matsutare SAITO. This sum, according to letter of June 16, 1945, from SUZUKI, was paid to SAITO by SUZUKI. The sum of \$50.59 has been received from M. EBISUZAKI Co. and has been credited to the account of Yoshikasu SUZUKI."

BONDS

SAITO reported 1 \$50.00 Victory Bond in his own possession. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT

SAITO reported an account in the Royal Bank at Main & Hastings, of about \$300.00. This was not brought under the control of the Gustodian.

There is very little that can be done in the way of protection of Japanese property at Stillwater.

follower Mr. Logan visited this place in June, 1942, and reported on 4/76 as

follows: **The two camps, Tairs and Susuki, are reached from Stillwater as

4 miles by car 9 miles by boat 1 mile on foot 4 miles by boat 4 miles on foot.

Total - 22 miles

to cross the lakes.

Mr. Logden checked all the equipment to be found in the two samp bunk houses and lists are given herewith. It was quite impossible to decide which tools belonged to which man. Additionally, there are also some tools left in the bush which can only be located by the Japanese themselves.

In short, such equipment as has been left behind is perfectly safe as it could not be removed without Mr. Nat McMair imouring about it. However, for the most part it cannot be identified and we shall therefore have to advise the Japanese concerned that we can only assume that the tools they have declared to the Custodian are actually there. It would cost more than the value of these tools to take them away."

Unfortunately, it appears that this report is a little optimistic as thefts of the McMair's Company equipment has since taken place. There is nothing, however, that can be economically done as appears from Mr. Nat McMair's letter of July 21st on file 2876 written in answer to a request of Mrs. Hideo MIYAMOTO for shipment of some of her effects. This is quoted below for the benefit of other Stillwater files.
