The above declared a debt of \$100.00 owing to the B. C. Packers Ltd. The B.C. Packers Ltd. did not send us in a bill for this account. We wrote to IKEBUCHI on Dec. 16/43 asking him if this account with the B.C. Packers was still outstanding but received no reply. We are today writing to the company asking them if this account has been settled.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: IKEBUCHI, Eikichi - Reg. No. 01300

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 2, 1942 and was evacuated on July 25, 1942.

CHATELS: He declared the following goods at 350 Powell Street:

1 Gunny sack of clothes	1 Bed and Spring
1 Trunk	1 Mattress.
2 Suitcases	

The premises at 350 Powell St. were the Hifumi Restaurant, operated by Yukio SHIMIZU, File 4056, cousin of declarant. This property was not Japanese owned; the agent for the owner was A. E. Austin Co.

The file does not reveal what became of the chattels. Neither does file 4056, Yukio SHIMIZU, nor that of his wife Kiyo, File 11813. We can only assume that, in view of the fact that IKEBUCHI never requested any of his chattels, he took them with him on evacuation. We asked IKEBUCHI to confirm this assumption but he never replied.

SPECIFIED

ARTICLES: He also declared a Gasoline Boat # N. W. 1844 which was turned over to the R. C. M.P. at New Westminster. This vessel was sold to Walter Nygren, on June 4, 1942, for the sum of \$500.00. Supervision costs amounted to \$7.50 and the balance, \$492.50 was remitted to IKEBUCHI on June 10, 1942. Inventory Claim No. 415 in the amount of \$49.85, against the Canadian Government was paid to the B. C. Packers Ltd on May 2, 1945, at the request of the Purchaser Walter Nygren.

He also stated that he had left a kitchen stove and kitchen utensils on board. These would be considered part of the equipment and included in sale price of boat.

NETS: IKEBUCHI did not declare any nets. However, on July 8, 1942 he advised us that he had sold nets 3, 4 and 10 to Mr. Burt of the Celtic Cannery. This would lead us to believe that other nets were left by him, possibly at the Celtic Cannery. During 1943, nets and other fishing gear, coming from Celtic Cannery were sold and credited to IKEBUCHI. This amounted to \$266.75 as will be seen from the attached Net Statement. IKEBUCHI was asked in October 1943 to complete a net declaration and told that should we received no reply from him, we would assume that he had nothing else to declare. He did not reply. A second enquiry was made in April 1946 to which he failed to reply. He has since returned to Japan. It is therefore assumed that IKEBUCHI had no interest in the nets and the proceeds are being transferred to Net Suspense Account.

This vessel was sold to Walter Nygren on June 4, 1942, by Eikichi IKEBUCHI, and as a condition of such sale all interest in claim for the loss and/or damage referred to herein was assigned to the purchaser. Walter Nygren, purchaser, has authorized payment to British Columbia Packers Ltd.

While in the custody of the Royal Canadian Navy, this vessel suffered loss and damage to the value of \$49.85, as assessed by the surveyor for Naval Service, which sum is approved by the undersigned and accepted as adequate compensation.

In consideration of the payment of the sum of FORTY-NINE DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-FIVE CENTS ----- (\$ 49.85 )

(of lawful money of Canada) (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), we, the undersigned, being the owners and/or mortgagees, shipyard repairers and all others having any interest, claim or demand against the said motor vessel registered at the Port of New Westminster, B. C.

Official or License No. 1844 DO HEREBY RELEASE and forever discharge His Majesty the King, as represented by Royal Canadian Naval Service or any patrol or auxiliary service, acting through or under the authority of Royal Canadian Naval Service, and all boards, commissions or departments of His Majesty's Canadian Government of and from claims which we may now have or which hereafter may arise and which now could or at any time hereafter be made in consequence of damage sustained or any alleged damage sustained, to the above-named motor vessel while in custody of His Majesty's Royal Canadian Naval Service or any auxiliary patrols, commissions, boards or departments hereinbefore named.

AND FURTHER, we covenant that we are the owners and/or mortgagees, shipyard repairers and all others having any interest, claim or demand against the said vessel and are the only parties or persons having any interest, claim, lien, demand or charge over the above-named motor vessel, and should any claim hereafter be made by or through any parties whatsoever, we hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless His Majesty the King as represented by any of the naval services, boards, patrols, departments, or commissions hereinbefore referred to.

AND FURTHER, that this discharge and release enures to the benefit of and is binding upon all the parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, successors and representatives.

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
