This was signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 19, 1942. He was evacuated on May 10, 1942.

Prior to his evacuation, OTSUINI was employed as a logger by the Robert Addate Shingle Company, (Taire Comp) Stillunter, B. C.

## CRASSING

OPENTABLE reported a list of logging equipment, some left in the bunk house and some in the bush. He reported also sixty-five cords of shingle board.

The evacuation from Stillenter was very sudden and the Japanese had no time to arrange for the shipment or storage of their goods. Ar. Green's seme of April 30, 1943, States that it was impossible to identify consciding of the tools found in the camps, and there were tools in the bush which could only be found by the Japanese themselves. For this resear, few or no Stillester chattels have been accounted for, and nothing further can be done in regard to OTSUTANI's equipment unless he should claim for their loss.

## GIADURITY SES

OTSUTANT reported a debt of about \$100.00 owing to Mr. Maseto TSUKAMOTO, File No. 11130, for the Sun Mooning Apartments. On July 2, 1942, a claim in the amount of \$60.00 was filed equiest OTSUTANT by TSUKAMOTO. This claim was referred to OTSUTANT in letters of Describer 15, 1943, and March 17, 1944, but no admoviedgment was received. TSUKAMOTO was advised to deal direct on October 8, 1947.
