The suitcase and gunny sack presumably contained his clothing and purely personal goods and would be taken with him on his evacuation.

The two radios, one a General Electric and the other a Marconi, were handed to the Custodian by the R.C.M.P. and were sold at auction for the total net sum of \$114.75 and this sum was credited to the account of the above.
