
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man, who was evacuated on April 9, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. In his declaration he reported ownership of the following assets:

Chattels: One Trawling Net and one Spring Net, stored at British American Cannery, Port Essington, B. C., on which an outstanding balance of \$60.00 was due the cannery. On August 17, 1942, the Anglo-British Columbia Packing Company Ltd. sent the Custodian a cheque for \$130.00 in payment for the nets of this man. These funds were credited to his account and later remitted to him.

Fishing equipment, stored at British American Cannery, on which an outstanding balance of \$100.00 was due the cannery. Nothing further appears on the file in regard to this, but the letter of August 23, 1942, from Setsuichi FUJII indicates that everything (including his liabilities) in regard to his gear had been settled to his satisfaction by the cheque for \$130.00 from the cannery company.

Vessel: The vessel "Matsue" described in Vessels Summary was sold by Setsuichi FUJII, through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, to the Anglo-British Columbia Packing Company Ltd. for the total sum of \$135.00. The committee's charges in connection with this vessel were \$1.35, and the balance of \$133.65 were paid to S. FUJII on March 26, 1942.

Accounts Receivable: The sum of \$5.00 was received from the Dominion Government in full settlement of claim, filed with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, for refund of expenses incurred in connection with the impounding of the vessel "Matsue". This sum was credited to the account of Setsuichi FUJII.

This file reveals that this man declared ownership of a quarter of an acre of land in Hiroshima-ken, Japan.

This file reveals no other personal or real property of any kind.
