
This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 23, 1942. He was evacuated on May 4, 1942.

In his declaration he reported carpenter's tools left with North Pacific Cannery. The file of his father, File 1270, shows that everything remaining at North Pacific Cannery in the name of the father was shipped to Greenwood and delivery was taken by the father. Among the articles shipped was a bundle of tools. It would appear likely that the tools declared by the son were in the shipment made to his father. In 1942 this man was 17 years old and living with his parents.

He declared 3 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no other property.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
