In his declaration this man stated that he was the owner of a fishing vessel in custody. This is the vessel described in the Vessel Summary filed directly behind this summary. This vessel was sold by the Custodian for the total sum of \$450.00. Vessel expenses amounted to \$73.11, the balance of \$376.89 was credited to the account of Shokichi UYEVAMA.

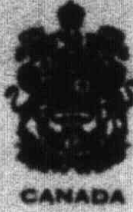

MEMORANDUM RE: Vessel "SU", "TU" Nan. 702, NW.037-J  
or "Janet" NW.1514, NW.037-J

1. The sheet of descriptive details turned in to JFVDC by Japanese boat owners gives: "S. U." NANAIMO 702, NW.037-J, 30'x7'x3.6', Easthope 6 H.P., hull built in 1933, Value:\$500.00, Registered owner: Shokichi UYEYAMA, Actual Owner: Tamotsu UYEYAMA, both of P. O. Box 228, Steveston.
2. Mr. Gould's survey shows: "T. U. 3240", NW.037-J, 30'x7'x3.6', S.E.P. Easthope, Owner: K. Hori.
3. Shokichi UYEYAMA's J.P. form gives: one Easthope gas engine fishing vessel, 22'x5'4"x3' at New Westminster in custody.
4. Sales papers in name of Tamotsu UYEYAMA to Mr. L. Cloke
5. Proceeds to credit of Tamotsu UYEYAMA (unregistered in Evacuee Section) and who, according to Miss Choze, is the same as Internee No. 691. The Evacuee File 13858 was made to cover boat owner.
6. Shokichi UYEYAMA (our file 1283) according to RCMP is owner of vessel Reg. No. 1514 New Westminster, Naval No. NW.037-J.
7. New Westminster No. 1514, according to Registrar of Shipping, New Westminster, is K. Hori (our file #1219 is most likely "K. Hori") This license number was issued May 4, 1926 (on hull built in 1933).
8. Naval Control No. NW.037-J applies to the vessel "Janet", white hull, 30'x 7', formerly owned by K. Hori, but transferred recently to L. Cloke, of Ladysmith (See paragraph 4).
9. I have written the Registrars of Shipping at Nanaimo and New Westminster for more details in regard to the two license numbers given, and to Shokichi UYEYAMA for more information regarding the boat owned by him.
10. Tamotsu UYEYAMA (Internee 691) is listed as a fisherman in partnership. No property. He may possibly be a son of Shokichi UYEYAMA.
