GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 1291

Re: Kanejiro OGINO, Reg.No. 03056

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. He was evacuated on April 9, 1942. He was repatriated to Japan on December 24, 1946.

In his declaration, OGINO reported ownership of one trunk and 3 large boxes and one bed at 22 West Cordova St. in his own possession. His personal effects he reported were in the trunk and boxes. The file gives no further information in regard to these effects and it would appear likely that OGINO took them all with him on his evacuation.

He reported a bank account of \$200.00 in the Bank of Montreal, Main and Hastings Street, Vancouver, B. C. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

In addition to the items reported, this file reveals that the fishing vessel "K.O." was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee and that the sum of \$198.00 representing the net proceeds of the sale was paid direct to K. OGINO on March 26, 1942.

This file reveals no other property.

Funds may be received from the Income Tax Department on behalf of Kanejiro OGINO in connection with tax over-payment.


