PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Takeichi OKAMOTO

This man, who was evacuated from the protected area on April 24, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942.

VESSEL:

In his declaration he reported ownership of a gasboat. This is the vessel dealt with in the Vessels Summary. The vessel was sold by Takeichi OKAMOTO through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, and the net proceeds of the sale, in the amount of \$170.75, were paid to him on April 7, 1942.

NETS:

He declared a sockeye net on which there was an outstanding balance of \$30.00 owing to the British American Cannery in whose possession the net was at time of declaration. He was willing to accept \$130.00 for this net. On July 9, 1942, the Anglo-British Columbia Packing Co. Ltd. informed this office that this net had been sold back to the cannery by OKAMOTO for \$30.00.

At B. A. Cannery, also, he declared there was a spring net, on which there was due a balance of \$65.00 to the cannery. This he was willing to sell for \$120.00. On this net the company paid to the Custodian \$25.00 after settlement of the outstanding balance.

A second spring net, at B. A. Cannery, on which the owner placed a value of \$85.00, was purchased by the company for \$60.00.

A coho net, on which he placed a value of \$40.00, was purchased by the cannery company for \$40.00.

A sockeye net, valued at \$25.00 by the owner, was reported by the cannery company to be valueless, in their letter of July 9, 1942.

The sum of \$125.00, in payment of the three nets purchased by the cannery through this office was credited to the account of Takeichi OKAMOTO and all these funds have been remitted to him.

ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE: The sum of \$5.00 was credited to this account in full settlement of his claim for refund of expenses incurred at the impounding of his vessel in December, 1941. This claim was filed with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee.
