

CHATELS:

Kanji OIKAWA declared that he left certain personal effects in the bunk house of Fraser Mills, New Westminster. Our agents, A. W. McLeod Ltd. were asked to locate and check the goods but reported they could find nothing except an old gramophone. Upon further inquiry of OIKAWA, he admitted on November 30th, 1942 that he had given everything, except the gramophone to the Salvation Army. The Custodian requested the B. C. Security Commission to ship the gramophone to him, leaving nothing further to account for.




Dear Madam:
