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PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

This man, who was evacuated on April 21, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942.

In his declaration, he reported ownership of a vessel and fishing equipment, valued at \$600.00, left with Sunnyside Cannery, Port Essington. He stated that he had arranged with British Columbia Packers Limited to purchase these and expected to receive \$600.00 from the company's Vancouver office.

A description of this vessel is given in the Vessels Summary, filed directly behind this summary. At time of impounding the vessel was in OHASHI's possession under a conditional sales agreement, B. C. Packers Ltd. were the licensed owners, and on April 1, 1942, the boat was released to the licensed owners from Naval Custody. In letter of May 1, 1943, B. C. Packers Ltd. informed this office that they had paid Shotaro OHASHI \$220.00 in full for his equity, and that they had received a Release from him accepting the settlement, *MARCH 27, 1942.*

It is not shown by the file that the fishing equipment was included with the boat in this settlement, but this may have been the case. Or it may be that the equipment was sold to B. C. Packers Ltd. separately. As OHASHI has not inquired about this equipment, it is probable that he disposed of this prior to his evacuation.

He declared also a \$100.00 Victory Bond, held by the Royal Bank of Canada, Prince Rupert. This did not come under the control of this office.

In addition to the items declared, the file reveals that on February 8, 1943, we received a request for the shipment to this man of one trunk, one paper box and one wooden box, stored in the residence of M. Ohashi, Port Essington. This request was passed to the B. C. Security Commission for attention. As nothing further appears on the file in regard to this, it would appear that shipment was made as requested.

The claim of \$600.00 against B. C. Packers Ltd. which was declared is covered by the settlement in regard to the vessel referred to above.

The sum of \$5.00 was received from the Dominion Government in full settlement of claim, filed with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, for refund of expenses incurred in delivering M.V. "S.O" to Naval Service at Prince Rupert, in December, 1941.

This file reveals no other property, either real or personal.

The file reveals no liabilities.

Attached hereto is Custodian's cheque for the sum of \$5.00, representing all the funds standing to your credit in this office.

In your declaration to the Custodian on March 24th, 1942, you stated that you were the owner of a vessel and fishing equipment valued at \$600.00, left with Sunnyside Cannery, Port Essington. British Columbia Packers Limited have informed this office that the vessel in question was in your possession under a conditional sales agreement and they stated that the sum of \$220.00 had been paid to you on March 27th, 1942, in full settlement of your equity in this boat.

We understand that the fishing equipment declared by you was sold by you prior to your evacuation as this office has no record of any equipment belonging to you remaining at Sunnyside Cannery.

In your declaration to the Custodian you also reported a \$100.00 Victory Bond held by the Royal Bank at Prince Rupert. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The sum of \$5.00 was paid into this office in full settlement of the claim filed by you with the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "S.O."

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the Protected Area, which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience and reply.


Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:
