The above numbered policy covering on the life of Mitsue MIYAMOTO, (in Japan) matured as an endowment on March 10th, 1944.

The proceeds amounting to \$705.12 payable to the assured Mitsue MIYAMOTO, were paid in to this office and received here on the 19th of April, last.

Mitsue MIYAMOTO, under the Regulations Respecting Trading with the Enemy, is considered an enemy and her property of every kind, is vested in the Custodian. Therefore, the money must be held here.

The beneficiary, Isakichi OGAWA, is not entitled to any part of the proceeds of this matured endowment. Therefore we can not accede to the request in your letter of September 20th. If by any chance, after the war, it is proven that Mitsue MIYAMOTO died prior to the maturity date of this contract, then and only then, would the beneficiary be entitled to make claim for the death benefits under the policy. Please be advised that nothing further can be done in connection with this matter at the present time.

With reference to the letter dated July 3rd, 1944, received from your address--please explain why that letter was signed "Mrs. Mitsue Miyamoto" as your mother was a parently in Japan at that time.

This 53-year old Fisherman from Skeena River, B. C., a Naturalized Canadian, signed a "JP" declaration form on the 24th March, 1942.

He was evacuated on the 21st April, 1942.

He declared his wife and 3 children to be in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Chattels: None.

Specified Articles: A Marconi Mantel Radio (and Batteries) was surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at Prince Rupert on the 8th April, 1942, and was sold, by auction in Vancouver, on the 24th March, 1944, for \$35.00; net proceeds (\$29.33) being credited to this Evacuee's account.

Bank Accounts: None. *Bank of 50.00 Victory Bond declared to be in owner's possession, did not come under the administration of this office.*

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: No claims are recorded against this Evacuee.

Funds: A balance of \$29.33 stands at the credit of this account at the present time.
