This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. He was evacuated on April 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported 2 nets stored with Inverness Cannery, Skeena River, B.C. On June 16, 1942 we received \$60.25 from J. H. Todd & Sons in payment of these 2 nets and a small boat. This amount was remitted to KARIYA on January 21, 1943.

The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this man was the owner of a vessel "Funie" which was sold and the net proceeds of \$245.00 were paid to KARIYA on March 31, 1942.


