The wife of this man stated in her declaration to the Custodian that she owed \$8.00 to the Prince Rupert General Hospital. We referred this debt to her three times but received no reply and as the Prince Rupert Hospital did not file a claim against this woman we are taking no further action.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 1343

August 16, 1946.

Re: Goichi HINADA, Reg. No. 10471

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 2, 1942. He was evacuated on May 30, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a trunk containing clothing, 11 chairs, a table, a box of kitchen utensils and household goods and a shelf left at his former address in Prince Rupert. The wife of this man, File No. 534, reported these chattels also but reported them left care of the Japanese Association. 12 chairs were sold and the net proceeds of \$11.32 were credited to the account of this man's wife. (The remaining chattels appear to be unaccounted for. See shipment of goods, which takes care of these goods.)

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and \$15.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

The R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Kodak Duex camera surrendered by this man to the B. C. Police at Prince Rupert. This camera is still on hand *mailed July 27/46*

On May 31, 1943 HINADA requested shipment of 2 stone pieces, 1 piece of iron and an iron pan, none of which he declared. Lacking evidence to the contrary we assume these were shipped. On March 20, 1944 Mrs. Arnold of Prince Rupert notified us that HINADA had requested shipment of some household goods, none of which was inventoried but might have been contained in the "box of kitchen utensils and household goods". Lacking evidence to the contrary we assume these were shipped.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$1.30 received from the Northern B. C. Power Co. Ltd. as refund of deposit.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

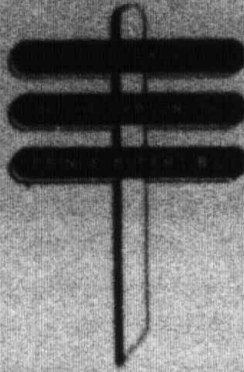

Some time ago we had a written request from above for the release of certain goods, and an enclosed money order for \$3.00 to pay for same. On Jan. 21st we wrote the B.C. Security Commission for a release for this shipment, but to date have heard nothing on the matter.

We have had a further letter from Hinada requesting immediate shipment, but will not send without the proper release. The steamship agent will not ship without this document.

The goods asked for were as follows,
1 basket con. bottles (filled with liquid) and 1
coffee bottle.
6 cans labeled "Awakeshi"
1 rubber hose.
1 small basket,
1 stone bowl.

His letter reads: The liquid substance in bottles is not expensive, but as it is not sold at any store, I would like great care taken in packing it.

Would you hurry this release, so that we can close our file on the matter.
