PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 1351

RE: Kanichi MATSUBAYASHI, Reg. No. 00877

This file reveals that Kanichi MATSUBAYASHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. He did carry fire insurance of \$1500.00 on his furniture with the Michigan Fire Insurance, but his wife advised us that this policy had been allowed to lapse in 1943.

CHATELS: Mr. MATSUBAYASHI made his declaration to the Custodian on April 2/42 and was evacuated on July 3/42. He declared chattels as shown on the Chattel Schedule. The Schedule also shows chattels declared by Mrs. MATSUBAYASHI.

Certain articles were not found by the Custodian as shown on the Schedule. These may have been included in shipments which were made by Mr. IWASAKI and Mr. Young from this address to various Japanese. No record was kept of these shipments so we are unable to do any checking in this respect.

Some boxes (no definite number given by Mr. Spain), were shipped at the request of Mr. MATSUBAYASHI to the Silk-o-Lina Ltd. at Calgary. It would appear that these consisted mostly of chinaware, glassware and books.

The balance of the chattels found by the Custodian were sold at auction for the net sum of \$317.15 and this sum credited to the account of MATSUBAYASHI with this office.

MONEYS The account of MATSUBAYASHI was credited with the sum of \$8.36, being a RECEIVABLE: refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. A Custodian cheque for this sum was remitted to him on Dec. 31/43.

LIFE He declared a life insurance policy in the sum of \$2000.00 with the Sun INSURANCE: Life Insurance Co. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

In his letter of May 12/44 MATSUBAYASHI requested that after the furniture had been disposed of, we pay the sum of \$5.00 to Mr. Young for his trouble in looking after goods at the Continental Daily News. Custodian cheque for this sum was sent to Mr. Young on June 13/45 and this sum was deducted from the credit of MATSUBAYASHI with this office.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
