GENERAL SUMMARY

Jinyemon TANIGUCHI died at Greenwood, B. C. on August 14, 1944. He is survived by his widow, Masayo and one daughter in Japan.

The deceased, in his Custodian declaration, stated that he owned a 18' Gas Boat, a Coho net and a box of carpenters tools. These articles were disposed of as shown on the Personal Property Summary attached and the monies derived therefrom were credited to the account of Jinyemon TANIGUCHI in this office. The sum of \$30.85 was remitted to TANIGUCHI on November 12, 1942. From an enquiry to the Royal Bank of Canada it is learned that the balance in the bank account, mentioned by the deceased in his Custodian declaration, was forwarded to him on February 2, 1944.

The only claim filed against the deceased is for the sum of \$90.90, to cover funeral expenses paid by the B. C. Security Commission. The balance now standing to the credit of the deceased in this office, \$14.25, is today being forwarded to the Department of Labour to apply against the funeral claim.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Jinyemon TANIGUCHI, Reg. No. 10790

This file reveals that TANIGUCHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any fire insurance.

CHATELS:

Mr. TANIGUCHI made his declaration to the Custodian on March 2/42 and was evacuated on May 1/42. He declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. The net was sold for \$25.00 to the Arrandale Cannery. From this they deducted \$17.15 owing to them by TANIGUCHI and the balance of \$7.85 was credited to his account with the Custodian.

We received the sum of \$23.00 from the Arrandale Cannery for lumber they had purchased from TANIGUCHI. This amount was credited to his account with the Custodian.

The total of these two sums, \$30.85, was remitted to TANIGUCHI on Nov. 12/42.

Mr. Walker, the Manager of the Cannery, stated that the tools left at the Cannery by TANIGUCHI had been stolen.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

TANIGUCHI was the registered owner of a fishing vessel, the "J.T." which was sold through the office of the Custodian for the net sum of \$14.25. This sum was credited to the account of TANIGUCHI in this office and is his entire credit balance. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE:

TANIGUCHI filed a claim against H. SAKAMOTO, for \$650.00. However he withdrew this claim in his letter of May 15/43. In a letter of Feb. 11/46 from Mr. and Mrs. SAKAMOTO, they advise that Mrs. SAKAMOTO had paid Mr. TANIGUCHI \$500.00 of this amount. It would appear that before the death of Mr. TANIGUCHI arrangements had been made regarding payment of the remaining \$150.00.

BANK ACCOUNT:


He declared a savings account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings St., in the sum of \$500.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
