

unclean; and living quarters are very crowded.

down without notice.

also that most of the assets are not worth
storing; and that failing Mrs. Nakamura being
allowed to carry on the business herself, it
should be sold as a going concern if possible,
which is doubtful.

Referring to your letter of the 24th. instant, we beg to advise that we investigated the above and find that Mrs. Nakamura is still carrying on the business of cleaning, dressmaking, etc. at the premises at 3917 Main Street, Vancouver.

In the report dated March 31st, 1942, we stated that Mrs. Nakamura said that all equipment was fully paid for. In this inspection we found that there is a power-driven sewing machine number J.B. 375424 which is not fully paid for. The agent's name is Yanogisawa who was connected with the Singer Sewing Machine Company 742 Granville Street, Vancouver, before his evacuation. The Singer Sewing Machine Company advise that there is still \$100.00 owing on this machine and that it is covered by conditional sales agreement. Mrs. Nakamura states that she will return the machine to the Singer Company if evacuated.

Mrs. Nakamura states that it is her intention to sell or dispose of the balance of the business equipment and that she will take with her personal belongings. As far as we are able to ascertain, the only liabilities are the \$100.00 owing on the sewing machine, and rent owing to A. M. Smythe, 176 East 23rd. Avenue, from the 7th. day of September, 1942.

We understand that the pressing machine referred to in your letter of the 24th. instant has been fully paid for, according to Mrs. Nakamura.
