CHATELS:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 2/42 and was evacuated on May 20/42, declared household furnishings for 6 rooms valued at \$100.00 left at House #21, Pacific Coast Cannery. Chattels found at this house marked with the name of "KITADE" were inventoried on June 24/42 by Custodian agent, Mr. C.C. Robinson in the name of "Y. KITADE", List #45. Y. KITADE is Yasuo KITADE, File 5931, a son of the above. These effects were moved to central storage. A copy of this list was sent to Mrs. KITADE on Nov. 30/42 to which she replied on Dec. 17/42 stating that the following articles should be added to the list we sent her:

1 Heater	1 Bath tub
1 Kitchen stove	4 Window blinds
2 Boxes kitchenware	600 ft of lumber
	4 fishing nets

On Oct. 26/42 the above sent a Custodian Release to the B.C.S.C. asking for shipment of a stove. This was shipped to her in Nov., 1942. Regarding the other items mentioned in her letter, one of the stoves and 2 boxes of kitchenware were not found by the Custodian. The bath tub and blinds were left in the house as fixtures. Mr. Robinson in reply to our memo asking about the lumber, advised this office by telephone on Feb. 4/43 that the lumber had been sold. The file does not reveal nor can the accounting department determine whose account was credited with the proceeds from sale of this lumber as it seems the amount was included in a cheque received from Robinson for various lots of lumber sold about that time. The nets were declared on the file of Yasuo KITADE, File 5931, and are dealt with on that file. Chattels belonging to the above have been sold at auction for the net sum of \$5.78, and this sum credited to her account with this office.

SPECIFIED
ARTICLES:

According to information received in this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "Y.K./S.K.", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee to the British Columbia Packers Ltd. for the sum of \$1050.00. A balance of \$397.82 was due the purchaser, and after deducting this sum and the supervision costs of \$15.50, a net sum of \$636.68 was left and this sum was paid to the above on April 9/42. Full details are given on the Specified Articles Summary on file.

WAR SAVINGS
CERTIFICATES: The above declared a \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in her own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
