This file reveals that Mr. SHINTANI owned no real property in any protected area of H.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

SHINTANI declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. None of the chattels were found at 1603 Franklin St. where he stated they would be left. We advised him of this in our letter of Oct. 30/42 and received no reply. As his wife had stated her intention of selling the chattels prior to her evacuation, it is likely that this intention was carried out.


Some chattels belonging to his wife were found stored with the goods of Mrs. MITSUGU at 746 E. Cordova St. and were sold for the net sum of \$5.81 and this sum remitted to her.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


