PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 2/42 and was evacuated on April 7/42, declared household and personal effects including 2 sewing machines, gardening tools, kitchen utensils and carpenters' tools valued at \$200.00, all at 944 W. 8th Ave., Vancouver, in the care of his wife and father. However, in his letter of Jan. 17/46, the above states that these goods all belonged to his father, so the proceeds from their sale were transferred from his account to the account of his father, Katsutaro YOSHIOKA, File 5413, on Feb. 21/46.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The sum of \$1.69 was received in this office in favour of the above from the Provincial Collector, Vancouver, representing wage deduction refund for the first six months of 1941. This sum was remitted to the above on Dec. 30/43.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATE: The above declared one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

Dear Madam: Re: Chattels left at 944 E. 8th Ave., Vancouver, B.C.

With reference to the above this is to inform you that the twenty-two boxes and one carton, making twenty-three packages in all, were declared by Mr. Katsutaro YOSHIOKA as being owned by him. These goods were removed in November 1942 to our warehouse at Powell Street and eventually sold by auction, the net proceeds after expenses were taken into account being \$35.00, and this amount has been credited to the account of the above.

We appreciate that twenty-three packages were also mentioned by you but in view of the definite statement that these were owned by your father-in-law, Mr. Katsutaro Yoshioka, we have taken it that the contents were his property.

As regards the remaining chattels, these were eventually removed to auction and sold for the sum of \$77.59, after allowing for auctioneering expenses, costs, and the above amount has been credited to your account.

The above takes care of the chattels that were left at 944 East 8th Avenue, Vancouver, and we would point out that it was quite impossible for us to make any further division of these chattels in view of the fact that several persons declared in their JP forms that they had left chattels at this address, but practically no details were given. In the circumstances we have done the best we can with regard to the allocation of the proceeds derived from the auctions and in order that our files may be completed in regard to this matter, we shall be glad if you will please sign the copy of this letter as no funds can be released until agreement is reached on this question of chattels.

A copy of this letter is being forwarded to the other declarants of chattels at these premises that they may know the action we have taken in this matter.

With reference to our letter of January 11th we had occasion to write to Mr. Katsutaro Yoshioka and inform him that the chattels sold by auction giving net proceeds of \$55.88 had been credited to his account. We have now received a letter from him dated January 17th in which he states that in addition to the above, the remaining chattels removed from the above address and sold by auction for the net amount of \$97.59 were also his, and that the above amount should be credited to his account.

In these circumstances, if you agree that all the chattels from 944 West 8th Avenue, Vancouver, belong to Mr. K. Yoshioka, will you please confirm this by return. In any event, unless we hear from you by January 24th we shall assume that you do not dispute Mr. K. Yoshioka's claim to ownership of these chattels.

A copy of this letter is being forwarded to the other declarants of chattels and we shall expect to hear from them also on this matter by the date indicated above.

You are doubtless aware that Mr. K. Yoshioka is on the list of repatriates, hence the urgency of this matter.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
