PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 25, 1946.

Re: Yohel TAKAMOTO, Reg. No. 10254

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 20, 1942. He was evacuated on March 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a 1-room house at Powell Lake. This house was built on land owned by Arthur Lyons who informed us that this shack was of no value and TAKAMOTO had no equity in the land.

In his declaration he reported furniture and personal effects valued at \$50.00 left in his house at Powell Lake. No disposition of these chattels appears on the file and we assume they were either worthless or TAKAMOTO arranged for shipment of what he wanted.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
