PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

RE: Minora SHIOSAKI, Reg. No. 03544

CHATTELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 2/42 and was evacuated on April 21/42, declared the following:

1 radio in custody of the R.C.M.P. at Vancouver  
1 Fishing vessel in custody of authorities at New Westminster  
7 nets and 17 lbs. of twine at the Phoenix Cannery net house at Steveston, B.C.

All nets found tagged with the name of the above were inventoried by Custodian agent Mr. C.C. Robinson at the Phoenix Cannery net house, and all but one given Custodian numbers, as shown on the Net Statement on file. This one net was sold direct to the Phoenix Cannery by the Custodian for the sum of \$125.00 and this sum was credited to the account of the above with this office. The remainder of the nets with the exception of nos. 603 and 609 were moved to Custodian net house on Nov. 2/42. These two nets together with the twine were apparently abandoned as of no value. The nets moved to Custodian net house were sold for the sum of \$225.50 and this sum credited to the account of the above with the Custodian. A net form was sent to the above on May 20/43 which he completed and returned to this office on June 14/43. He stated at this time that all these nets belonged to him and that none were the property of his brother Shigeji, File 2645.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES: According to information supplied to this office the above was the registered owner of a fishing vessel the "Rose Beauty", which was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee for the net sum of \$690.50 and this sum was paid to the above on April 13th, 1942. Full details are given on Specified Articles Summary on file.

The file reveals that the radio declared by the above was not his property but belonged to his brother Shigeji, File 2645. This information is contained in a letter of May 29, 1944, from the above. This radio has been sold and the proceeds credited to Shigeji SHIOSAKI.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: In July, 1945, the account of the above was credited with the sum of \$1.49 being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: The above declared one \$5.00 War Savings Certificate in his own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: The above declared a savings account of approximately \$10.00 in the Royal Bank of Canada at Steveston, B.C. This account did not come under the control of the Custodian.

At the request of the above the following remittances were sent to him from his credit with this office:

After deducting these various remittances there remains a balance of \$8.99 standing to the credit of the above.


