
Re: Hidetaro KUBO, Reg. No. 08843

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 23, 1942. He was evacuated on August 25, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a set of kitchen utensils left at Wilson Creek. On June 4, 1942, he requested shipment of kitchen utensils and other chattels including a trunk declared by his wife, File No. 519. Lacking evidence to the contrary we assume these were shipped.

He reported a bank account with a balance of \$100.00 in the Bank of Montreal, Vancouver. This did not come under the control of this office.

Re: Mr. & Mrs. Hidetaro KUBO

Mrs. Kubo declared a trunk left in Mr. Jackson's care at Wilson Creek and Mr. Kubo a set of kitchen utensils only, at the same place. These were all applied for and presumably shipped in June 1942. Neither Japanese has answered letters dated September 15th and 19th asking their confirmation that they have no chattels left in the protected area.


